He made the request on his radio show (The Catholic Hour) that his listeners "embrace the world in prayer." To do so he introduced this Rosary, with different colors for each

decade representing each of the five continents. Green reminds us of the forests

and grasslands of Africa.

We begin our journey around the world in prayer this month with Africa. As we pray a decade of the Rosary, let us focus our prayers on children and families in need on this continent.


